Roads:

The N4 is in great condition, expect road works through the Middelburg area.

The main road through Belfast is in a poor condition, guys with trailers to be mindful of potholes. No robots are working, all intersections should be treated as 4-way stop streets.

The road (R540) between Belfast and Dullstroom is in a fair condition, but dangerous, please be vigilant.

Weather:

Dullstroom can have 4 seasons in one day, we expect rain and mist as a rule during the summer season.

Shopping:

Basics are available in town, do not expect a mall. Refer to rally magazine for options, discounts and advertorials.

Meat: Butchery closes at 17h00, frozen meat is available at the convenience stores.

Groceries: At entrance of town at garage is a convenient store called Lebamba Supermarket.

Drinks: At the entrance of town at garage is a liquor store, as well as further down the main road on your right as you exit the town to Lydenburg, closes at 17h00 daily

Water in town is 100% drinkable.

No take-away outlets, most restaurants offer a take-away option.

Take specifics what you need with you, most will be driving through Belfast which has a SPAR, be careful if you plan to stop there as it is a crime hot spot area.

Petrol/Diesel:

Both garages are open 24 hours

Car repair services:

There are no services in Dullstroom, even tyre repairs need to be done in Belfast.
