MAINTENANCE WORK TO TIE IN NEW M9 PIPELINE CONNECTION TO EXISTING M8 PIPELINE AND TO TIE IN THE NEW N6 TO OLD N6 PIPELINES

Rand Water hereby notifies you, as per our shutdown protocol of our planned maintenance work to tie in the new M9 pipeline to the existing M9 pipeline as well new N6 to the old N6 pipeline. The duration of the planned maintenance will be 59 hours starting from 18:00 on the 26 May 2023 to 05:00 on 29 May 2023.

During the planned maintenance, there will be no pumping at Bloemendal and Trichardt Pumping Stations, Wildebeestfontein Reservoir will as a result will be affected.

During the planned maintenance, all areas within the Govan Mbeki Local Municipality will be affected should the Wildebeesfontein reservoir run empty.

Recovery time will be approximately 5 days after pumping has resumed. Recommendation is that Victor Khanye Local Municipality fill their reservoirs as well prior to the planned maintenance.
