WELCOME to the 2019 RALLY OF SOUTH AFRICA

Held in Mpumalanga South Africa, Pre - Rally Activities, Thursday 25th April 2019

Thursday Afternoon – SHAKEDOWN STAGE - SABIE: (Shakedown Stage - York-OLIFANTSGERAAMTE)

- The shakedown stage will be held on a section of Stage 1 between the Lone Creek Falls road (D2220) and the Long Tom Pass (R532 Sabie-Lydenburg road).
- **From Nelspruit, proceed with either:** (See map for **All Stages** & detailed map for **Stage 1**)
 - a. The R40 towards White River & then the R537 to Sabie
 - b. The R37 towards Sabie/Lydenburg up to the T-Junction turn-off & then the R532 to Sabie.
- **Start of Shakedown:** From Sabie proceed with Main Street (R532) north towards Graskop, turn LEFT in Lydenburg Road towards Bridal Veil Falls/Lone Creek Falls, drive out of Sabie past the Bridal Veils Falls and the York Timbers Sawmill. The start of the shakedown stage starts on the left just past the end of the sawmill grounds. See Map for Stage 1 (**refer GPS 2**).
- **Middle of Shakedown:** From Sabie proceed with the R532 towards Lydenburg up to either the 51/66 km or 51/0km Sign Post. On arrival, park your vehicle next the R532 at one of the points as per the map and watch the rally cars circulating on the stage.
See detailed Map for Stage 1 (**refer GPS 3**).
- You are also welcome to browse around and view the rally teams at the Service Area next to the York Sawmill on the D2220, as they change the set-up of their vehicles & then run the shakedown stage repeatedly to improve their performance.

Thursday Evening - SABIE PITSTOP - SABIE:

- From Nelspruit for ±60kms, proceed either:
 - Turn LEFT in the R40 towards LYDENBURG (R37) and then travel past Rosehaugh and Hendriksdal, at the T-Junction with the R37/R532, turn RIGHT towards Sabie (R532).
 - To the R40 (White River / Barberton road) and then travel towards White River, just before White River turn left at robot and travel towards Sabie (R537).
- On arrival in Sabie, proceed down main Road in the direction of Graskop, turn LEFT into Lydenburg road and then RIGHT into the premises of the FLOREAT RIVERSIDE LODGE, park your vehicle & join the various activities at this venue. See the **SABIE Town** map.
- You can join and meet the different Rally Teams to view their cars and get some autographs and posters.
- A pre-rally decal check and scrutineering of the rally cars will take place in front of the CONFERENCE CENTRE at the Floreat Riverside Lodge from 16h00 until 17h00.
- Documentation for the rally will take place at the RIVERSIDE HALL on the premises of the FLOREAT RIVERSIDE LODGE in Lydenburg Road.

- Please stand in safe spectating positions - see the guide on the Right & follow the instructions by our Crowd Control Marshals.
- Motorsport South Africa request you not to Drink & Drive whilst spectating on this event – we value the lives of other road users.

ENTRANCE INTO “YORK & MTO FORESTS”:

- Please note that Spectators are ONLY allowed in the forests at the designated points as per this Guide.
- Spectators are NOT allowed to drive into forests with their vehicles at any place, you may only walk in.
- NO FIRES are allowed in or near forestry areas.



- The **SABIE Service Park** is at the **York - Sports Grounds**, just outside Sabie on the Lone Creek / Bridal Veil Falls road - See Service Map "Pre-Event", "A, B, C, D, E, F, H & i".
 - **In Sabie from Point "A" (See "SABIE Town" map – S = 25° 05.900', E 030° 46.760'):**
 - Proceed with Main Road towards Graskop (R532),
 - ±0.8 km - Turn Left into Lydenburg Road towards Bridal Veil Falls/Lone Creek Falls
 - ±2.7 km - Straight over unused railway crossing,
 - ±2.9 km - Turn Right onto gravel road at S/P York - Sports Grounds,
 - !!! Oncoming Rally cars
 - ±3.2 km - Straight through Narrow Gate (enter York - Sports Grounds)
 - ±3.4 km - Fork Left & find a parking spot to the Left on the soccer field
 - Please Do Not Obstruct the flow of the Rally cars and service crews.
 - **Walk around the outside perimeter of the bunted off service area & watch the servicing / repair activities of the rally teams.**
- The **MTO-Rutland Remote Service Park** is next to the Bedrock Rutland Mill on the **R40** between White River and Hazyview and is ±8.4km from White River (±6km from the big roundabout at Casterbridge).

FRIDAY, 26th April 2019 - Day ONE

START OF RALLY - Sabie Market Square

- 1st Car Due: 10h00**, Rally cars will leave at 1 minute intervals - See map SABIE Town
- From Nelspruit, proceed to the R40 (White River / Barberton road) and travel towards White River, just before White River turn left at robot towards Sabie (R537).
- On arrival in Sabie at the Market Square area, park your vehicle to ensure a quick exit towards Graskop.
- View the rally cars in the Pre-Start Holding Area (from 09h00 in the Town Hall parking area) & watch the flag-off ceremony @ 10H00 for the first 5 to 10 cars in the Sabie Market Square parking area.
- The rally cars will drive northwards from the start down Main Road and proceed towards Klein Sabie, to drive through Simile where they will pass next to three Schools, before returning to Sabie to drive out towards Lone Creek Falls for the Start of Stage One next to the York Sabie Sawmill in Lydenburg road.

- **START of STAGE:** (On Lydenburg Road (D2220) towards Lone Creek Falls)

- **EXCELLENT Spectating – HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**

- 0.0 km - From Point "A in Sabie proceed northwards in Main Street (towards Graskop)
- ±0.8 km - Turn LEFT in Lydenburg Road (in direction of Bridal Veil & Lone Creek Falls)
- ±2.9 km - Keep Straight on at Turn-off to York - Sport Grounds Service Park
- ±3.2 km - 4-way STOP, Crossroads, Keep Straight on
- ±3.8 km - Straight on – START of Stage 1 on Right next fence of York Sabie Sawmill
- ±4.1 km - Excellent Spectating over next 200m on RIGHT

- **GPS 1 - First car due @ 1 = ±10h23, 2 = ±11h36**

- **NEAR START of STAGE:** (On the Lydenburg Road (D2220) near the Start)





Area map of Service Park Location




Service Park Layout

- A major "spectator" stage close to Sabie with many good spectating points.

Stage & Roads Description: Fast roads with loose red dusty surfaces, very slippery if wet. Starting next to the York Sawmill in Lydenburg Road, running through an old log storage yard, before crossing the D220 tar road into the Olifantsgeraamte Forest for a fairly flat section traversing backforth in the trees, then uphill the around the mountain top, followed by twisty & turning roads along the mountain contours below Longtom pass, finishing close to Lone Creek Road/Horse Shoe Falls turn-off.





- **END of STAGE:** (On Lydenburg Road (D2220) 1.9km from Start of the Stage)

- **SPECTATING NOT ALLOWED**

- ±4.7 km – Follow Marshal’s instructions to pass the Stage/Tar road crossing point
(This is **NOT RECOMMENDED**)
- ±6.4 km - End of stage is 0.5km on gravel road to Left
 - **Do Not Enter OR Obstruct this exit road for both stages 1, 2, 3 & 4,**
thus fast approaching (oncoming) rally cars from ahead.

- **Spectating at the End of the Stage NOT ALLOWED**

- **First car due @ 1= ±10h32, 2 = ±11h46**

- **MIDDLE of STAGE:** (Just below Long Tom Pass on the R532 starting at 51/6km)

- **GOOD Spectating – RECOMMENDED**

- 0.0 km - From Point "A" in Sabie continue southwards with Main Street towards Nelspruit / Lydenburg (R532/R37),
- ±1.5 km - Straight on out of Sabie (Sabie Station to right)
- ±2.9 km - Straight on (Hillwatering Country House to right)
- ±3.5 km - Straight on, S/P R37 Mashishing - 52 km on left
- ±3.9 km - Turn RIGHT ("51/6 km" distance sign post on right)
- ±4.2 km - Fork Left
- ±4.4 km - Fork LEFT and Park, walk ±200m to Spectating Point:

- **The rally cars will approach up hill into a Hairpin Right before disappearing into the forest.**

- **GPS 3 - First car due @ 1 = ±10h25, 2 = ±11h38**

OR:

- ±3.9 km - Keep Straight on, (Road to right & "51/6 km" distance sign post on right)
- ±5.6 km - 50/0 km distance sign post on right – Do Not Park around the next blind corner
- ±5.65 km - Roads & Big Rock to right, end of spectating section for SS 1
 - 1. **From this hillside, rally cars will become visible between the trees at intervals in the valley below while traversing up & down the forest - you will be able to see them for a number of short bursts as the cars enter/exit the trees.**
 - 2. **The cars will finally emerge on the east straight ahead from the trees and make two right turns just below the big rock before disappearing northwards along the hillside below Long Tom Pass.**

- **GPS 4 - First car due @ 1 = ±10h26, 2 = ±11h39**

- **!!! - NOTE 1:** Please do not obstruct normal traffic flow on Long Tom Pass. Please park safely on side verges of the road & away from the tar’s edge over this spectating section.

- **!!! - NOTE 2:** Please do not enter the bunted off areas with your vehicle.

- **!!! - CAUTION:** - No Spectator vehicles will be allowed to enter this point, as all the roads on the hillside will be used by the Rally Cars, park your vehicle in a safe place next to the tar road (not on the blind corner) & walk back to the entry point. **DO NOT ENTER** these roads with your vehicle - there will be no place to park it or exit during the running of the stage.




Stage 3 / 4 = An idea of the valleys of the "Longridge" forest as seen during the route survey for the 2019 YORK Rally

Stage & Roads Description
 A typical forest stage, starting close to the R537 at the Hendriksdal/Witwater crossroads, the first section with many Contours (Yumps) is winding/twisting along the natural mountain contours, then mostly wide & fast down-hill with many contours (Yumps), then northwards into a twisty forest section before turning southwards down to Sabie along the Vertroosting Pass, finishing close to Sabie at the Spitskop forest village.

- START of STAGE:

(Close to the Witwater/Hendriksdal crossroads on R537 between Sabie & White River)

- Limited SPECTATING (Out of the main spectating flow)

- The Start is on a gravel road ±350m west of the Hendriksdal / Witwater crossroads, 12 km from Sabie on the R537 between Sabie & White River.
- Limited Spectating if you walk-in ±250m past the starting point, a fast left up-hill sweep over contours & then into the forest.

- First car due @ 1 = ±11h09, 2= ±13h17

- MIDDLE of STAGE: (Close to Hendriksdal Village on a Gravel Road)

- See instructions as for Stage 11 (& 12) up to:

Stage & Roads Description
A specially build SPECTATOR stage to finish the rally off is held close to Sabie Town, starting on a gravel forest road next to the R532 from Sabie towards Lydenburg/Nelspruit.
It features a crossover bridge & its zig-zags down the hillside for EXCELLENT / HIGHLY RECOMMENDED spectating in the valley below the Escom powerlines.

NOTE:

- NO SPECTATOR VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE VALLEY BELOW THE ESCOM POWERLINES.
- NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE BUNTED-OFF ZIG-ZAG AREA BELOW THE ESCOM POWER LINES, STAY NEXT TO THE TREES AND THE YORK GUESTS TENT.



- ±18.0 km - Straight on at Option 2
- ±18.2 km - Park on left next to tar road & **SPECTATE** on left in the area next the road


