Northern Regions Rally Championship as part of the 2019 Rally of South Africa

Regional Bulletin 1

MSA Northern Regions Motorsport Circular Nr 04/2019 refers.

Competitors who wish to score points in Northern Regions Rally Championship (Regional) can enter the Rally of South Africa Day 2 ONLY. Competitors doing the whole event may also score points in the Regional should they register for the same.

MSA GCR's, SSR's, Rally of South Africa SR's (where applicable) will apply. These are available from www.sarally.co.za and www.sarallying.co.za.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you enter in the correct Class as per the MSA Northern Regions Motorsport Circular Nr 04/2019 Paragraph 9.

A special Entry Form for Regional Entries as well as all the Rally of South Africa Event Documents will be available on www.sarally.co.za. Please download and print your own Rally Documentation. Entry forms accompanied by your Proof of Payment to be submitted via e mail to samrallies@mweb.co.za as well as wlow75@gmail.com. **Regional entries close on the 19 APRIL 2019.**

The Entry Fees will be R1 000.00 for entering the Regional event only, or a Reduced Fee of R500 if you are also entering the full National event:

Regional Only	R1 000.00
R2 National + Regional	R6 000.00 + R500.00 = R6 500.00
Classic National + Regional	R1 500.00 + R500.00 = R2 000.00
Open National + Regional	R2 500.00 + R500.00 = R3 000.00

Please note, that if you are entering the National and Regional events, you must complete Two Entry Forms.

Your Entry Fee will include a set of the Jemba route notes. The videos of the stages will also be available for downloading on www.sarally.co.za under the Route Note section.

Documentation and Scrutineering for Regional Only Entrants will take place at the start of SS8 (Spaghetti Junction Stage) in Ferreira Street, Nelspruit on Saturday morning from 06h00, and will close at 07h00. Unfortunately NO latecomers will be accommodated. You are welcome to come through to



documentation on the days before, should you happen to be in Sabie. Rally Headquarters will be at the Floreat Riverside Lodge in Sabie – Refer Rally of South Africa Supplementary Regulations.

You need to arrive with your duly completed self-scrutineering form. This form will be available on www.sarally.co.za.

All Rally Decals will be provided by the event organizer. Class Decals will be available at Documentation/Scrutineering at R50 per set.

For Reconnaissance refer to MSA Northern Regions Circular No 4/2019 – Par 13.4. For competitors only entering the Regional event on Saturday, you will be able to Recce the stages for Saturday on Thursday. Refer to the Events Supplementary Regulations Appendix 2 for the Recce Schedule. Competitors wishing to take part in the Recce must mark the appropriate field on the Regional Entry Form.

Results will be published as per the Rally of South Africa Supplementary Regulations.

Prize giving will take place immediately after the FIA Podium Prize giving. Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Overall positions as well as for class winners will be awarded. Food and Refreshments will be available on sale at the Finish Venue.
