#### **4. Thursday, 26 September:**

- 4.1 Unofficial Shakedown stage will be part of stage 1 @ Willem Prinsloo Museum.
- 4.2 The Shakedown stage will operate from 14h00 – 17h00
- 4.3 Please make sure to sign an attendance sheet / indemnity at the start and make sure that passengers have signed an Indemnity at the timing marshals at the start of the stage
- 4.4 Please note that crews will participate in FULL Race gear.
- 4.5 Passengers to wear long pants and closed shoes, no Sandals or “Plakkies”

#### **5. Friday, 27 September:**

- 5.1 Recce is open to All Entered competitors.
- 5.2 Please adhere to the set Speed limits for both Stages and Open sections.
- 5.3 Make sure to first go through Documentation @ Willem Prinsloo Museum before you go to Scrutineering.
- 5.4 Entries must be accompanied by proof of Competition License.
- 5.5 Ensure to submit your Medical questionnaires to the Rally Secretary before the event.
- 5.6 R2N competitors must bring their tyres to Scrutineering for marking.

#### **6. Saturday, 28 September:**

- 6.1 Re-start will be at 07h30 from Willem Prinsloo Museum.
- 6.2 All Cars to be in Holding Area by 07h20.
- 6.3 You need to sign on again at Willem Prinsloo Museum before Restarting.
- 6.4 Event Registration for REGIONAL competitors from 06h00 to 07h30 @ Willem Prinsloo Museum.
- 6.5 Scrutineering for REGIONAL and SUPERALLY from 06h00 to 07h30 @ Willem Prinsloo Museum in the Service area.
- 6.6 The Podium Ceremony will happen as soon as the winners are in and the cars will be parked at the podium before going for post-scrutineering. All other cars can go into Parc Ferme.
- 6.7 The actual prize-giving will be a spit-braai at 18h00 where the trophies will be handed out. Please make sure to collect your tickets at documentation on Friday afternoon. There will be NO tickets for sale on Saturday evening – please book extra tickets from the Rally Secretary before the close of business on Thursday, 26 September. The ticket is R120.00 per person.
- 6.8 There will be a cash bar in operation at the prize-giving venue but you are welcome to bring your own drinks.

6.9 All Regional competitors please take note that by entering for both days you can score DOUBLE point towards your Championship.

## 7. Etags vs Cards

- 7.1 You will not be required to pay toll fees during the rally.
- 7.2 Once you arrive at Willem Prinsloo, TRAC staff will hand out cards (like a credit card) at documentation, which you should use for the duration of the rally.
- 7.3 The cards will be linked to your car registration number.
- 7.4 Should your vehicle be fitted with an eTag, it should be removed to avoid double payments, as these cannot be reversed.
- 7.5 The cards should be presented when you go through the Diamond Hill toll gate or any of the ramp plazas. If you do not have a card, you will be required to pay the toll fees.
- 7.6 The cards will automatically be terminated on Sunday.
- 7.7 Cards should be destroyed by the user.
- 7.8 Cards should not be abused.

  - Instruction 24 – Change 13.33km to 13.20km
  - Instruction 25 – Change 13.79km to 13.51km
  - Instruction 26 – Change 14.74km to 14.46km
  - Instruction 27 – Change 15.10km to 14.81km
- 8.3 SS 5/7 - Instruction 47 (14.86km) Change to Turn Left through Gate Keep Right
